Frequently Asked Questions

What ages can attend the Early Learning Center?

Children who are between 2.9-years-old and five-years-old not entering Kindergarten.

Where will the program be located?

The program will be located at 227 Elm Street in our Upper Lang Building, Early Learning Center.

What are the hours of operation?

The hours of program are from 7:30 am to 5:30 pm.

How many slots are available?

There are 20 slots available.

Will you accept Care 4 Kids?

Yes. Parents are responsible for applying for this Connecticut care subsidy program.

Do you have any discounts?

If you are a WHCH employee who would send a child or grandchild, there will be a \$25 per week discount. We will offer a \$25 per week Sibling Discount on the second child+.

Is the Early Learning Center Licensed?

The Early Learning Center is pending license approval by the Office of Early Childhood.

Will you be open year-round and during school holidays?

We are open year-round. We will be closed from 12/24-1/1. The West Haven Community House Holiday Schedule will be provided annually.

Do you provide meals?

Children will bring their own lunch. Nutritious snacks will be provided.
